These meetings included discussions on strategies for developing more integrated services and efficient maintenance solutions for various fleet types.













GMF also leveraged the momentum of MRO Asia Pacific 2024 to maintain good relationships with other MRO provider such as Lufthansa Technik, SR Technics, AFI KLM E&M, Turkish Technic, and Malaysia Airlines Berhad Engineering Services. These discussions aimed to not only strengthen existing partnerships but also identify new opportunities for cooperation that could enhance GMF's technical and operational capabilities while maintaining its competitive edge in the global market.
